

1:32 Tracked Wood Chipper Resin Model Kit

1x Body, 1x Chute, 1x Exhaust, 1x Hopper, 1x Hopper Extension, 1x Chassis, 1x Small Fuel Tank, 2x Tracks, 1x Large Tank/Control Box, 2x Small Pins.

CLEAN ALL RESIN PARTS IN WARM SOAPY WATER

The silicone release agent used in the casting process will react with paint, it must be thoroughly cleaned off before painting.

This is a rough guide to using the kit. Care should be taken at each stage to make sure the model is going together correctly and any alterations that are not in the instructions should be carried out.

Paint: Components can be painted at any time in the build, it is a case of what suits the builder

Glue: Recommended glue is contact adhesive or super glue.

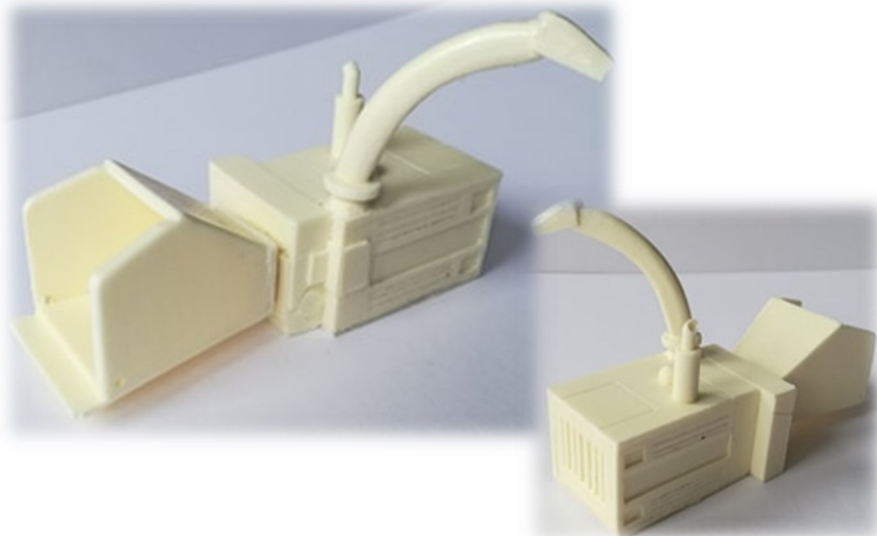


1 Clean Flash. The first step is to clean the parts in soapy water and, with a craft knife remove any flash left over from the casting process. This is thin lines of material that accumulate along the joins in the mould.

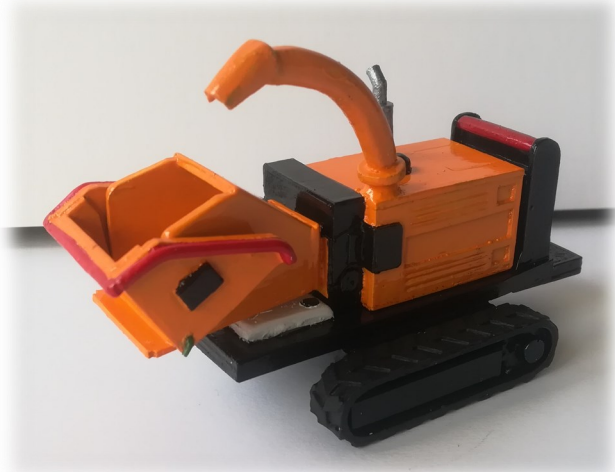
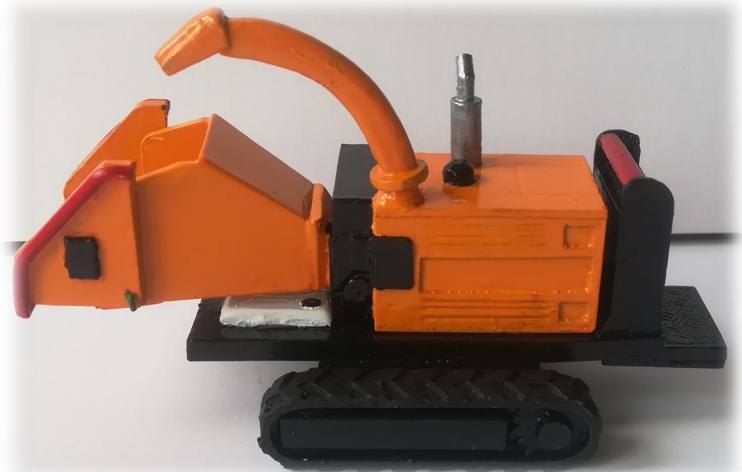
2 Assemble the chassis. Glue the tracks to the chassis, central to the mounts, with the sprocket at the front and the lugs pointing to the back. Glue the front tank/control box to the front. And the small fuel tank to the back as shown in the photos.



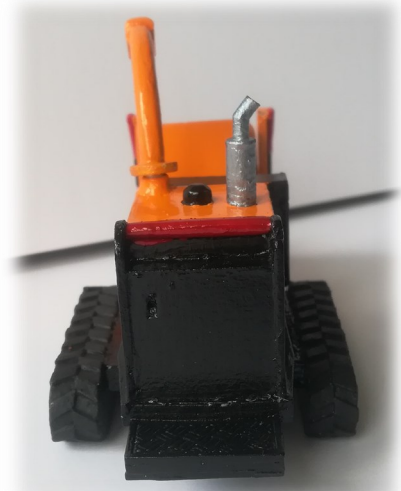
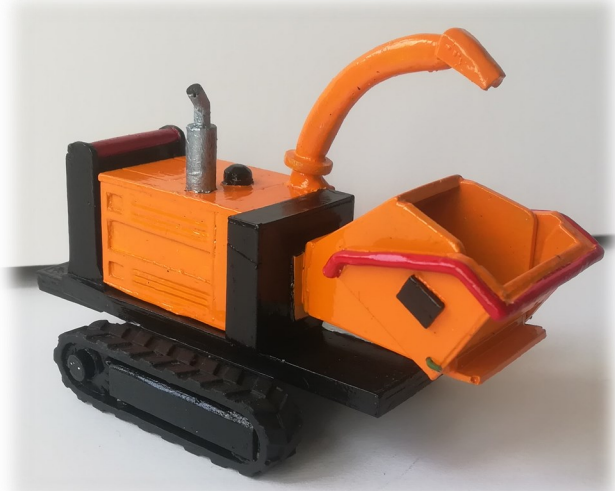
3 Assemble the body. Glue the hopper to the back of the body as indicated by the slots. Glue the exhaust to the top of the body. If you want the chute to be fixed also glue that in place. If you want it to rotate leave it unglued and paint separately.



4 Paint the parts. Apply any filler to the model where air bubbles are present. Paint all the components of the model as desired and allow the paint to fully set.



5 Assemble the model. Glue the body to the chassis. Slide the folding section of the hopper on, and secure using the two small pins.
