It's founders, Malin and Richard Muskala, run the company with the vision to challenge every person's curiosity with playful, flexible and accessible design. A brave stride, reaching far beyond the boundaries of Scandinavia. With in-house production and the help of local partners Mizetto is contemporising the traditions of local furniture production.


Mizetto is not only synonymous with local production and hard-to-beat quality, but also award-winning design. A handful products have received BOY Award, HIP Award and Best of Neocon, to name a few.

Mizetto's Summer collection 2023 blurs the boundaries between home and office, and between work and play like never before. Common for the pieces is that Mizetto, more than ever, has explored its own boundaries and possibilities by taking on products new to the Scandinavian design brand. They have investigated new materials, new productions methods and not least new functions. Like seating. But also leaning, lingering and loitering. If you will.

The Summer collection consists of a wooden chair, a versatile table with numerous attachments and attributes, an upholstered leaning piece and a set of containers making recycling fun and beautiful. Everything made in Sweden, as always, and carefully overseen by founders Malin and Richard Muskala at the heart of the brand.







LUMBER

Stepping out of their comfort zone, Mizetto launches its first ever upholstered product, a soft beam to perch on. Designed by Addi, Lumber answers to the need to linger for a while in places where traditional seats are redundant or too spacious. Lumber is upholstered with flame proof wool in a cover fully removable, reparable, and exchangeable. Its legs are made from powder coated metal, flat-packed, easily assembled, and available in all five colors for the Summer collection.

Lumber appears to be in movement, much as its user on their way to or from a meeting, waiting for an appointment or perhaps food pick-up. With no obvious back or front, Lumber can be placed in most spaces and even hung on a wall for maximum expression yet minimal space. A little side table enables a quick meeting over a coffee, a touchdown with the laptop or a as a tray to show off and photograph one's EDC kit.


Lumber is inviting and its message is clear; perch on me without any strings attached.






PLANT HERE


Let's face it, plants are smarter than people and will outlive us all. Therefore, they deserve the best pedestal possible to shine on. Much like people though, they have different needs and abilities, which Plant Here by Addi carefully caters for with its accessible and playful design.

For years Mizetto has worked on developing the perfect planter, but none of the ideas bare fruit. Until now. The modular Plant Here answers to the many needs and functions of a modern urban farmer or office gardener. For example, by raising the planter from the floor and keeping your plant friends in eye height when working, one can through a loving glance without losing focus from your screen. But also, the dimensions and functions of the planters are adjusted to specific needs, such as a generous depth, an inner planting pot for flexible planting and easy maintenance, as well as different heights, shapes, sizes and colors. Combined they form playful green islands and attention-grabbing installations, and the possibilities are almost endless.

ENFOLD

A wooden chair is quite a stretch for Mizetto, mostly known for personal office storage and products for the creative workspace. The idea of a chair grew strong over time and lately also the need as the company experienced a lack of seating opportunities in their own spaces. But, rather than buying an existing chair, Mizetto decided to create a new and unique product. Richard Muskala, founder, and chief of product development reflects:

"First human beings moved into caves, then we made chairs. And since then, we've continued, more or less. Perhaps it's a primitive urge to create things, but for us at Mizetto it's more about learning and evolving both as people and as a brand."

For the help and much-needed expertise to develop a wooden chair Mizetto contacted Finnish furniture designer and woodwork extraordinaire Sami Kallio. Shortly thereafter Sami walked into Mizetto's factory with a fully functioning prototype under his arm. "A few alterations later, Enfold was born; a chair that seemingly hugs its user. I love how it can be hung on a tabletop and stacked, but still provide us with all the beauty and comfort we seek in a piece of furniture," Muskala continues.





PELICAN

Pelican is a practical must-have turned into a decorative object and eye-catcher. This pedal bin with touchless interaction is a series of recycle urns for the modern office that doesn't compromise with taste nor the environment.

Pelican comes in two sizes and a variety of colors. Its minimalistic design and modular shape work both as a solitary piece, as well as combined in a group of two or more. Placed back-to-back they become an oval shape and placed in a row against a wall they form a cloud-like organic shape. Its refined character makes the bin suitable both for the domestic environment as well as a larger recycling station in public spaces and offices. Pelican is designed to make a difference in places where it has the most potential to make a big impact, the office. Recycling may come as natural as drinking tap water in Sweden, but in many other countries and areas it still needs to be nudged and encouraged. Pelican recycling bins make it easier to make a good choice, the right choice.

UNDERSTAND

Understand is a sculptural shelfing system and room divider for many different environments.

A jewel or piece of art, as much as a storage unit, where different modules create a freestanding entity. The furniture system plays with the idea of gravitation and has no clear limits or limitations, with its levitating boxes and shapes. By placing the boxes differently, either hanging or resting on the steel frame, practical shelves and beautiful voids can be created. Even a pot for greenery can be added.

Bin There is the elegant and mobile way to handle waste at the office.


Two cylindrical containers are placed on a metal tray, gracefully held in place by a thin metal frame. The bins are available in three heights and the trolley in two sizes, Small and Large. Handles and containers both have crafted details in natural tanned leather from Tärnsjö and wooden lids. The containers are both functional and beautiful on their own, for example as flowerpots.

The trolley and bins have a slightly rough lacquered finish and come in the colors Olive Green, Copper Brown, Antracit, Signal White and Beige.


BISTRO

The main difference is Bistro's wooden top tray for transport of a Swedish fika, perhaps, or small bits and bobs for the workspace. The lower metal tray holds two cylindrical bins for waste, gracefully held in place by a thin metal frame. Both trolley and bins are gifted with beautifully crafted details in natural tanned leather from Tärnsjö.


ARKIV & ARKAD

Arkad is together with Arkiv and Arkityp part of an elegant product series for waste disposal, perfectly adapted to stand together, or alone. The aesthetic is based on the archetype waste bin, but with playful and thoughtful details added. Typical function with atypical shape.

Arkad is the most minimal in shape and comes without handles. The bins are often placed on a wooden base as a duo or trio. Like its sibling Arkiv it comes with a variety of add-ons, like symbols and texts in different languages, as well as lids for cans/PET-bottles and paper. It's available in Signal White, Antracit, Terracotta, Pale Green, Latte and Deep Burgundy, with a volume of 100 liters or about 26 gallons.

Arkityp is together with Arkiv and Arkad part of an elegant product series for waste disposal, perfectly adapted to stand together, or alone. The aesthetic is based on the archetype waste bin, but with playful and thoughtful details added. Typical function with atypical shape.

Arkityp comes with wheels and a handle and knob in solid birch. It's available in Signal White, Antracit, Terracotta and Pale Green and has a volume of 200 liters or around 53 gallons.

Shadow play over the surface of inner depth.


Everything is about relationships: Shadow to light, surface to depth. The distance between us. With a deeper meaning. Frame gives life to movement in storage.

Hangout is a natural companion at the office; a high desk for the activity-based workspace, a mobile and easily-accessible space for quick and creative meetings where thoughts can flow freely.


The table combines a surface, for showcasing and pinning things, with a room divider thanks to its multifunctional sides. The piece is constructed with dimensions optimized towards a

light expression. Hangout is, as it sounds, a place for the spontaneous conversation or meeting, free of distractions like wires or builtin tech. Under the tabletop is a hidden storage space and a whiteboard can easily be attached to one of the sides. Hangout is placed on casrtors and easily glides through doorways, in and out of elevators and between furniture.

The table can take many expressions with its variety of elements, colors and materials.

BESIDE

Beside is a shelfing unit on wheels, an office trolley-system based on modules to perform and perfect every need a modern workspace has. On its main body structure a variety of accessories can be attached and hung, such as shelfs, hooks, drawers, pen-organizers, and magazineracks. By attaching and organizing shelfs in different configurations many different needs can be met.

The separate units can be attached to each other, forming a sideboard, a bench, or a wider storage solution on castors. And on its own, Beside is the perfect helper and storage unit for the modern office when one needs to move around and readjust the space.

Beside comes in two different heights and a combination of wood and metal, lacquered in a variety of colors. The perfect way to customize and personalize parts of the office space.

EDIT

Edit is a versatile and playful shelf with user interaction at its core. Graphical to look at and practical to work with, it allows the user to create personal and unique compositions and visual games like a piece of art.

A groove running along the shelf with two partitions inserted helps to support items as well as creating little barriers between objects, books, frames, and other items.

With time and personal touch, each Edit becomes spatial and can be modified by adding, moving, removing, and adjusting the items on it.

With Edit, alone or in a group, one can easily add a splash of color to the office or domestic environment.

The combination of oak veneer and powder coated metal in a wide range of warm and earthy tones sends a strong message of modern interior design with a Nordic touch.


TRAYSI

Traysi is the tiny detail that adds a little extra something to the office or workspace; a place to store and sort, or perhaps to keep and transport. The trays, in sets of three, are as much a decorative sculpture as a functional and mobile way to store small beloved things.

The playful design with multiple layers, in combination with exaggerated rounded corners, is inspired by nature's diversity. Like leaves on a vine, Traysi can link different office areas together. The tray sets are available in three colorways which can be combined freely. The matt finish of the lacquer has a slight structure for extra resilience.








Bloom is available in wall-mounted or freestanding variations, and can be combined with different elements to create a warm and welcoming atmosphere. The powder coated metal comes in eight standard colors in combination with oak plywood.


SOFFICE


Soffice is a series of different products acting as accessories and helpers for the domestic or professional modern workstation. Made of plastic waste, reduced into fiber and thermo compressed into the new material felt, four products have been created from the same mold.

The series include a larger organizer with a handle to carry things such as cables, notebooks, tools or devices back and forth from a locker or storage. It also includes a cable storage box with a wooden lid, a small business card or pen-organizer, both for the desk, and last by not least a lower toolbox, also equipped with a handle and smaller compartments for various things to be kept in place.

The Soffice series works well as a family and as separate pieces and will happily hold anything from Lego pieces and freshly picked herbs to post-it notes and a coffee thermos.






STUDIO NOOI

Studio Nooi was founded in 2020 by Giulia Pesce and Ruggero Bastita in Torino, Italy. Nooi is the amplification of the Italian word "noi" ("us"). The idea behind it is that design is never an individual act but rather a collaborative process, involving designers, companies, users, artisans and technicians. Nooi's designs are always the result of good cooperation between people and are influenced by society, art, nature and cultural heritage. Studio Nooi is closely involved at every stage of the project development, always aiming to achieve designs that are refined and rich of content.

"As designers, we like to play with the idea of allowing the final user to personalize industrial products. In this way, despite the standardization of industrially produced goods, every piece can be slightly different from each other, thanks to the different ways the users interact with them. We like the idea of involving the end user in making choices related to the product. In the case of Edit, users can move, add and remove elements actively contributing to define the product form and function.

The topic of personalization of the product is often present in our designs and in our collaboration with Mizetto we pay particular attention to this. We think that personalization is an extremely relevant topic in offices, where people spend a major part of their daily lives. In these contexts we think it's very important that workers can adjust and adapt their workspace depending on their needs and personal taste, creating a functional and welcoming environment which can adapt to different individuals and contribute to their well being."

ADDI

A multidisciplinary design studio focused on human centered design based in Kalmar, Sweden.

The name stands for - ADD: Inspiration, Interaction, Ideation & Innovation.

"The creative process is never linear, it's iterative, so we usually see it as a circle with our four I's (Inspiration, Interaction, Ideation & Innovation) making up all of the pieces. And just as a circle does not have a definite start, a project can start at any point in the circle. Then we add the other "I's" as they are needed to bring the project forward, and complete the circle.

In every project, we mainly focus on INSPIRATION and INTERACTION, in other words - understanding & empathy. A smart person once said: "If you have the right tools, half of the work is already done." And we firmly believe that if you understand what the right question is, then you are halfway to the solution. The problem is that even though we are staring right at the problem, we're not seeing it. It takes a lot of practice to notice the obvious.

And doing your research is key!


Every project is unique and requires different solutions, but we always strive to have an open dialogue with the producer. We want to be present and take part in manufacturing.

By being a part of the process we get to know the production team and learn more about their possibilities. That's why we like working with Mizetto so much. They are still striving to keep

things local and that makes the process much easier.

This goes back to the important part of Interaction and empathy."
