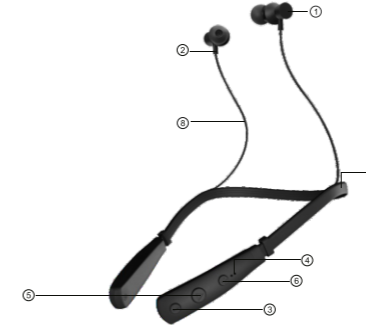

How to connect

1. Power on default bluetooth playback mode
2. Turn on the bluetooth the headset switch, turn on the default bluetooth mode.
3. Open the phone menu. turn on the bluetooth switch, and search for bluetooth devices;
4. Click "Urban X2i" in the list of searched devices to connect is successful, you will hear a tone, that is, the connection is successfully paired.

How to use

Charging

1. Connect the charging port with any USB charging adapter computer USB Port.
2. Charging will start automatically with LED indicator turns red
3. The earphones are full charged when LED indicator turns blue

Note : Make sure the battery is full charged before putting the earphones away from storage .Charge the earphones at least once every 3 months when not using for a long time.

Pairing

Power on: Long press the multi-function button for 3s until the blue flash and red light flash alternatively, then the head set will give a prompt tone "power on"

Power off: Long press the multi-function button for 6s until the light off, then the headset will give prompt tone "power on"

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Please keep the distance between headset and mobile phones within 10 meter.
2. Long press the headset MFB button for 3 seconds till the blue and red lights flash alternatively, the headset enters into bluetooth pairing mode, with a prompt tone "Connected"
3. Open mobile bluetooth functions search devices and search for the headset pair name "IB URBAN X2i"
4. Select headset name "IB URBAN X2i" for mobile phone matching
5. Completion of pairing, you will hear a prompt tone "connected", the headset is paired with mobile phone successfully.

Operation & Function

| Volume Increase | : Short press to play the next track
long press the volume to increase |
| Volume Decrease | : Short press to play the previous track

| Play / Pause | : Long press the volume (+ / -) button |
| Power button | : 1. Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds, then turn it on and hear the power on tone.
2. Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds, then turn off the computer and hear the shutdown tone.
3. During music playback, short press to pause/play. |
