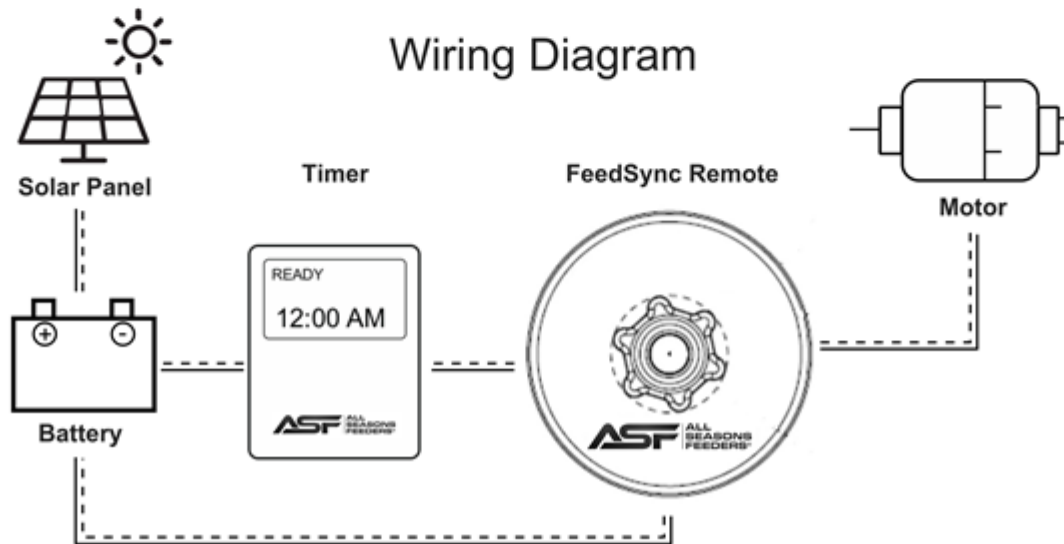

TIMER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

➤ **If using the All Seasons Feeders brand control box:** Using a screw driver and hammer, knock out the plug located on the bottom center of the motor control box

➤ **For all other control boxes and custom installations:**

1. Identify the install location (make sure you have good visibility to the antenna from your hunting blind / stand for best results)
2. Using a 9/16" drill bit, drill a hole into the control box.
3. Follow steps 2 – 10 below



Start

1. Remove the LARGE nut on the antenna side of the FeedSync Remote and insert it through the hole from inside the control box.
2. Re-install the LARGE nut to secure the FeedSync Remote to the inside bottom of the control box.
3. Install the antenna onto the FeedSync Remote



Connect Antenna

1. Connect the FeedSync Remote +- wires (red / black) to the battery
2. Connect your Timer +- wires to the FeedSync Remote lead wires (labeled TIMER +-)
3. Connect your Timer +- wires to the battery
4. Connect your motor +- to the FeedSync Remote lead wires (labeled MOTOR +-)
5. Connect your Solar Panel +- wires to the battery

2. Select the **FeedSync Remote** and connect



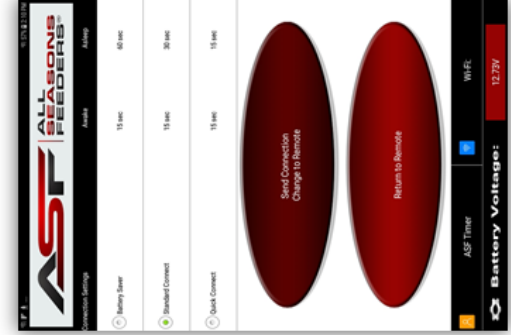
3. You're Connected! Click **HOLD** button to activate the FeedSync Remote



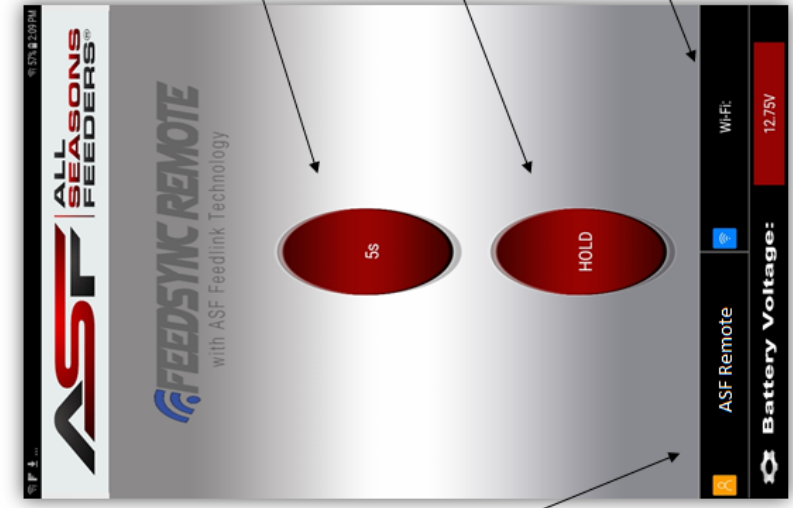
