

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, 40 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

The Independence Collective Limited Licence Number 45/OFF/003/2023

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), The Independence Collective Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol from the premises situated at 1/21 Ihakara Street, Paraparaumu and known as Change Maker Beer, to any person for consumption off the premises.

Endorsement

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. The remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6am and 11pm.
3. No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
4. All deliveries of alcohol must be signed for by a person aged 18 years or over.
5. Ordering of alcohol must require the buyer to declare in two places that they, and the recipient of the alcohol if a person other than the customer, are both 18 years of age or over.
6. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
7. The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the safe and responsible consumption of alcohol, and minimising alcohol related harm.
8. A copy of, or a link to, the licence must be prominently displayed on Facebook and any website used for online ordering.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
