## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLACEMENT OF SHADYHOLLOW24A/B, SHADYHOLLOW30A/B, SHADYHOLLOW36A/B, LMF24-MS, LMF30-MS, LMF36-MS, LMF24M0A/B, LMF30M0A/B, AND LMF36M0A/B LOG SETS.

Installation and service must be performed by a qualified installer, service agency or the gas supplier. Any safety screen, guard, or barrier removed for servicing an appliance must be replaced prior to operating the heater. The fireplace screen or guard designed for this unvented appliance must be installed prior to operation.

IMPORTANT: Read the owner's manual carefully and completely before trying to assemble, operate or service this fireplace. Improper use of this fireplace can cause serious injury or death from burns, fire, explosion, electrical shock and carbon monoxide poisoning.

### **INSTALLER:**

Leave instructions with the appliance. CONSUMER: Retain instructions for future reference.

This is a complete Log Set and shall not be used otherwise. This log set shall not be used for replacement of single logs.

It is very important to install these logs exactly as instructed. DO NOT MODIFY LOGS.

Failure to position the parts in accordance with these instructions or failure to use only parts specifically approved with this appliance may result in property damage or personal injury.

CAUTION: Burn hazard! Logs will remain hot after use. If you need to reposition any log to maintain the proper layout, use heat resistant gloves or allow logs adequate time to cool before handling.  Remove the entire Log Set provided and check for damage. If damaged, STOP!!! Contact dealer or IHP.
If you currently have a log set installed: Remove the entire Log Set that is currently installed on your Gas Log Burner and discard entire set.

3. Follow the steps found beginning on this page for installation of your new complete Log Set.


1. Figure 1A shows how the back left log must fit against the end of the burner. Figure 1B found on page 3 shows how the notch in the back left log fits against the vertical portion of the burner tube. Place this log on the base assembly by inserting from the left side as shown in Figure 1. You will need to twist the log slightly to get it to fit against the burner tube properly. It will rest even with the back edge of the pan.






Vertical Portion of Burner Tube Figure 1B - Installing Back Left Log Rear View

2. Charred log has a slot in the bottom that fits over the square grate and rests against the round burner tubes as shown in *Figure 2*.




Figure 3B - Installing Right Front Log, Top View

3. The right front log has a rectangular shape on the bottom that fits against the lip on the black metal base, the square grate, and the burner tube. Slide the right front log in place. For reference, *see Figures 3, 3A, and 3B*.





Grate Finger Figure 3A - Installing Right Front Log, Top View








Figure 4A - Installing Front Left Log Side View

4. Find the front left log. *See Figures 4, 4A, and 4B*. The log has a rectangular stand off on the bottom that fits against the lip on the black metal base as shown in *Figure 4A*. The bottom of this log has a slot that fits over the second bar on the grate as shown in *Figure 4B*. Place the log on the base as shown in figures.




Grate Finger Log Slot Figure 4B - Installing Front Left Log

5. Find the middle split log. The split side of the log faces forward. See *Figure 5.* The log has a notch that fits around the burner tube on the right side. The left side of the burner tube fits into the notch on the back side of this log. See *Figure 5A*. The log is placed properly when it sits parallel to the tube burner and the square peg is pointing up. For reference, see *Figures 5 and 5A*.




6. Find the right split crossover log. The bottom of the log has a rectangular stand off that fits in the slots on the right side of the right front log and the middle split log. Place this log as shown in *Figure 6.* 




7. Find the back top log. The left end of this log has a round hole that fits over the round peg that is on top of the middle split log. The right end of this log has a rectangular hole that fits over the rectangular peg on the top of the right crossover log. For reference, see *Figures* 7 and 7A.



8. Install the small left top log as shown in *Figure 8* by mating the rectangular peg and notch.



9. Install the small right top log as shown in Figure 9.



After setting the logs into position as described above, ensure each is properly and firmly seated. The vent-free gas log set will not function as intended if the logs are not correctly positioned. When placed properly, the flames will not strike any portion of the logs. Periodically check the positioning of all logs to ensure proper log placement and stablility. If any flame is striking the logs, recheck log placement. Adjust to conform with instructions. There should be no flame impingement on the logs.

#### EMBER PLACEMENT

**WARNING:** Do not use any other ember material not supplied with this unit.

WARNING: Do not operate unit without ember material correctly in place as shown in *Figures 9 and 10*. Do NOT place ember material anywhere else on the unit. Use only ember material supplied with unit. Excessive or incorrectly placed ember material may produce carbon monoxide or soot. If replacement embers are needed, the replacement embers must be purchased from IHP. See *Parts Section in Owners Manual* for part numbers.

# WARNING: ALL PREVIOUSLY APPLIED LOOSE MATERIAL MUST BE REMOVED PRIOR TO REAPPLICATION.

 Two ember materials are supplied with this log set. Platinum Bright Embers give a bright glow appearing as hot coals. Should embers need replacing, see <u>Parts Section in Owners Manual</u>.
Platinum Bright Ember placement. Add embers to front, flat burner. Gently remove embers from bag. Separate pieces of ember material and place on surface of flat burner just behind horizontal ports as shown in *Figure 9*.

**Glowing Embers placement.** Place Glowing Embers material on front flat burner in areas away from ports as shown in *Figure* **10**.

 Add volcanic stone and small decorative logs around base of heater if desired. DO NOT place rock or additional logs on front burner or on logs. Placing any material on unit other than ember material on front burner may result in production of carbon monoxide or soot.
