## Remove Deep Stains on Porous Tile and Natural Stone

## **Tools You Will Need:**

Scrub brush or nylon pad, rubber gloves, and at least 2 white cotton towels.

## **Recommended Products:**

Natural Stone Deep Clean or product that is safe or recommended for use on natural stone surfaces.

## What To Do:

- 1. Test a small area with your cleaning solution and wait 24 hours to ensure product does not cause discoloration.
- 2. Sweep or vacuum over the affected area to remove all loose debris. Put on rubber gloves for protection.
- 3. Cover the stain with undiluted Natural Stone Deep Clean, or follow the instructions provided on your other cleaning product.
- 4. Let the solution sit over the stain for 1-2 hours without letting it dry. The stain should lessen in visibility.
- 5. If two hours have passed and your stain is still visible, use the scrub brush or nylon pad to work the stain out.
- 6. Wipe up the residue with one of your white cotton towels and rinse the area with clean water.
- 7. Dry the surface thoroughly with your second white cotton towel.
- 8. Repeat as necessary to fully remove the stain.

<sup>\*</sup>Area may appear darker from moisture and the tile should fully dry out in 2-4 days. Keep traffic away from treated area until dry.
