#### VERIFY ALL ITEM MEASUREMENTS

Our site gives width, depth, and height details for each furniture item. We also offer the diagonal dimension for sofas, chairs, and sectional units. The furniture's width should be narrower than the height of any doorway, stairway, or corridor it has to go through. The diagonal depth should be narrower than the width of any associated doorway, stairway, or hallway.



### ASSESS THE DESIGNATED SPACE FOR YOUR FURNITURE

Decide where you want to position your furniture. Look at the width, depth, and height of the item on our site, making sure it matches the space you've picked out. You might consider drawing a scaled floorplan or using painter's tape to mark the furniture's size on the floor.

#### CHECK THE DELIVERY ROUTE

Plan the most efficient route from outside to the room where your furniture will be set up. Take measurements of every doorway, elevator, stairway, and corridor the furniture will traverse. If you're in an apartment or a house with an elevator, measure the inside height of the elevator, the width of the elevator door, and the space to the opposite wall. Also, measure the space between


the entrance and the opposite wall, especially if the furniture has to turn. Match these measurements with your new furniture's dimensions to ensure our delivery team can smoothly move through entrances and around any barriers.



#### **DOORWAYS**

- Measure the interior width and height of every doorways
- Determine how far your door can swing open.
- Note any architectural features that might obstruct entry.

#### **STAIRWAYS**

- Measure the width of your stairs, considering handrails or posts.
- Measure the height between the top and bottom steps to the ceiling.
- Ensure the furniture piece can accommodate landings.

- Determine the hallway's width, factoring in any bends or curves.
- Look out for architectural elements and overhead fixtures that might obstruct passage.

Please be aware that our delivery team is not authorized to relocate existing furniture in your home, nor can they handle electrical setups or take doors off hinges. To ensure a smooth delivery, kindly prep your home before our team's arrival:

- Make way by relocating any obstructing furniture or art pieces.
- Safeguard any dangling light fixtures.
- Position your rugs accordingly.
- Keep pets in a separate area.

Please ensure that the furniture pieces can comfortably pass through access points such as doorways, stairways, hallways, elevators, and around corners to their designated location.
