

To connect Melbourne sectional sofas together using alligator brackets, follow these steps:

- 1. Locate the alligator brackets on each sofa section it's on the bottom of each section, near the corners.
- 2. Position the two sections so that the brackets on each sofa are facing each other and aligned.
- 3. Push the two sections together until the brackets on each sofa interlock. You may need to apply some force to ensure a snug fit.
- 4. Check that the two sofas are securely connected by trying to pull them apart or wiggle them. If the connection feels loose, adjust the position of the sofas and try again.

Once the sofas are securely connected, you can arrange pillows.



To release the connection between two sofas that are connected using alligator brackets, follow these steps:

- 1. Locate the brackets on the bottom of each sofa section that are connected together.
- 2. Push down on the release lever or tab that is located on the top of each bracket.
- 3. While holding down the release lever, gently pull the two sofa sections apart.
- 4. Continue to hold down the release lever until the brackets are completely disengaged from each other.
- 5. Once the brackets are released, carefully separate the two sofa sections from each other.

It's important to note that when releasing the connection between two sofas that are connected with alligator brackets, you should take care not to damage the brackets or the sofa frames. If you encounter any resistance or difficulty when releasing the brackets, stop and double-check that you are pressing the release levers correctly and that the sofas are not still engaged.
