Keep away from direct sunlight: Prolonged exposure to sunlight can cause the fabric to fade over time. Position your bouclé upholstery away from direct sunlight or use window treatments to protect the fabric.

Protect from pets: Keep pets off the bouclé upholstery or use a protective cover to minimize the risk of scratches, stains, or hair accumulation.
