Before removal and installation, please thoroughly read these instructions. For your safety, pleaseread the contents of this booklet to properly install and use the Padded Cargo Liner. Keep these instructions with your vehicle records for future reference.



• There are several <u>A</u> WARNING and <u>A</u> CAUTION sections in this booklet concerning safety when installing or removing the Padded Cargo Liner. Always read and follow the instructions in order to prevent injuries, accidents, and possible damage to the vehicle.

**CAUTION :** Indicates a situation in which bodily injury or damage to the vehicle could result if the caution is ignored.


- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque by using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses (), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary.
- Do not modify the Padded Cargo Liner.
- Do not install the Padded Cargo Liner in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in doubt, please contact your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it. Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.





## 2. SIDE PANEL INSTALLATION




1. Move rear seats forward to allow for access to cargo area from rear door opening.




2. Locate the Padded Cargo Liner Left Side Panel.

Note the protective felt on bottom edge hook and loop fastener, do not remove yet.



3. Attach hook and loop fastener on back of side panel to form armrest shape.




4. Place side panel tightly against vehicles side panel.

Align front edge of Padded Cargo Liner side panel to leading edge of trim as shown.

Locate and align the opening of the Padded Cargo Liner to the cargo hook and vent on the vehicle side trim.

5. Secure the hook and loop fastener strap through the hole and around the cargo hook as shown.



6. Clean front edge of side panel with Isopropyl alcohol. Do not touch surface after cleaning.

Making sure side panel is in position, peel liner from adhesive side of hook and loop fastener located on front edge of side panel.

With a wiping motion, press hook and loop fastener down firmly to the vehicle side panel as shown.


7. Ensure the side panel is leaning against the vehicle trim for proper placements of the hook fasteners locate at the bottom of the side panel.

Peel protective felt from hook fasteners and attach to trunk board as shown.

8. Locate Bungie loop at rear of side panel. Pull and loop over rear cargo hook.



## **3. FLOOR PANEL INSTALLATION**




9. Place main panel into rear of vehicle and align edge of main panel to the front edge of the trunk board trim as shown.

Move 2nd row of seats to most rearward position. Position back of seats to in normal sitting position.




10. Raise the 2nd row headrests, and then attach head rest strap to secure main panel.

Lower the 2nd row headrests after installation.



11. Clip rear panel to side panels to complete the installation.



12. Congratulations! You have completed the installation of the Genuine Padded Cargo Liner.

# INSTALLATION INSPECTION SHEET

## Padded Cargo Liner KR9EV0360/KRSEV0360

#### Perform the following inspections

### **A** IMPORTANT INSPECTION ITEMS -

• These inspections and check are important for safety and legal compliance.

### - 🕂 WARNING -

- Check that there is no one directly in front of or behind the vehicle and that no one is near the engine compartment before starting the vehicle's engine. Sudden vehicle movements may result in serious injury.
- Do not start the engine in indoor places with poor ventilation such as garages. Exhaust gases may build up and cause poisoning or suffocation.
- Be sure to park the vehicle on a level surface and block the wheels before carrying out any operation checks.
