- Do not install the cargo net in any way other than described in the following instructions.



1 Preparation

- 1. Open lift gate.
- 2. Locate the mounting locations on the passenger side of the vehicle as indicated by the arrows (Fig. 1).



2 Installation

- 3. Remove the carpeted trunk floor (Fig. 2).
- 4. Using the provided template labeled as "RIGHT SIDE", place and fold the template in place using masking tape (Fig. 3). Note: Before marking ensure the hole locations are located inboard of the edge of the side compartments. Holes should not be located on the main wall of the side trunk panel.
- 5. Using the grease marker, mark ALL locations that are to be drilled. Remove the template (Fig. 4).






- 6. Ensure ALL marked hole locations are inboard of the edge of the side compartments. The mark should not be located on the main wall of the side trunk panel (Fig. 5 Vehicle Front/Rear).
- 7. Using the 1/4" (or 6mm) drill bit and drill stop set at 1/2" (or 13mm), drill the hole locations (Fig. 6).
- 8. Remove the right side carpeted trunk floor (Fig. 7).






- 9. Remove the lower tray (Fig. 8).
- 10. Remove the trunk floor (Fig. 9).
- 11. Remove the trunk sill plate by lifting up with your hands to disengage the clips (Fig. 10).
- 12. Remove the push-pin retainer from each side of the trunk sill plate (Fig.11).










Fig. 12 Fig. 13

- 13. Remove upper hook with ratchet and 10mm socket (Fig. 12).





Fig. 14 Fig. 15

- 14. Remove plastic cover from bottom D-ring (Fig. 13). Remove bolt with ratchet and 10mm socket (Fig. 14).
- 15. Gently disengage the Side Sill panel clips, by pulling towards the driver side. DO NOT disengage the entire Side Sill panel (Fig. 15).






Fig. 16 Fig. 17

- 16. Place Upper and Lower T-anchors with stud, through front hole opening (Fig. 16).
- 17. T-anchor with stud shown on backside of panel (Fig. 17-18).
- 18. Using the provided washer and rubber well nut, tighten the T-anchor until snug. The T-anchor should rest in a vertical position (Fig.20).

- 19. When snug, the rubber well nut will expand as shown (Fig. 19).
- 20. Check that T-Anchor is in Vertical position. Perform the same steps, for the remaining hole locations (Fig. 20). Note: The 2 front anchor locations require the well nut and washer to be installed blind from behind interior panel. Do not drop washers or well nuts behind panel.
- 21. Re-install interior panel, upper hook, and bottom D-ring.
- 22. Install Side Cargo Net (Fig. 21)
- 23. Repeat all steps for driver side.
- 24. Reinstall all remaining trunk components.





