
NAILED DRESSER

Nailed Dresser is designed and crafted exclusively by Bibbings & Hensby for The New Craftsmen. Whilst mudlarking on the foreshore of the River Thames, the duo found several hand forged nails, which prompted their research into historic forms of nailed furniture. Made exclusively with historically faithful nails hand forged by a traditional blacksmith, and without glue or complex joinery, the dresser explores the possibilities for the humble nail in contemporary handmade furniture.

Customisable options:

- Size: Bespoke sizes possible dependent on size and estimated finished weight. Please enquire
- Material: Standard options available include: oak with milk paint riven handles, oak with plain riven oak handles, white washed ash with milk paint riven handles, white washed ash with plain riven ash handles. Milk paint colour options include: Pumpkin, Federal Blue, Marigold Yellow, Pitch Black, Tavern Green
- Design: Bespoke designs possible including custom internal solutions (adjustable shelving/ drawers / doors etc)

Additional notes & guidelines:

- Colour tone and grain of the timber may vary
- N.B. Scratch lines can be seen all over the furniture, a traditional way to line up nails in vernacular furniture and a further example of the makers commitment to celebrate authentic methods in this piece
- This item comes edge protected as standard but can be crated for international delivery (POA)
- For international delivery this item can be shipped in 2 parts. Please ensure the top shelving unit is
 fixed in place to the lower cabinet using fixing provided. For domestic orders, the unit will be delivered
 fully assembled
- Clean with a damp, lint free cloth
- Wipe spills immediately to avoid the chance of obvious marking
- Always use protective mats to avoid staining
- Avoid use of abrasives when cleaning
- As with any natural timber product, wood can be susceptible to movement with change in conditions
- Avoid storage adjacent to direct heat sources including under floor heating or radiators
