Requires 6 x LR44 batteries (included).



BATTERY WARNING:

Should not connect to more than the recommend number of batteries.

Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.

Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.

Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.

The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.












The football must only be inflated by, and batteries replaced by an adult. Inflate with a hand pump (not included).

<p>ITEMS REQUIRED:</p> <p>TOOL INCLUDED:</p>  <p>BATTERIES REQUIRED: 6 x NEW LR44 (3 per Light Unit)</p> 	 <p>STEP 1: Please deflate the ball and insert the tool into the edge of the caps and prise open the caps.</p>	 <p>STEP 2: Use the hook side of the tool to pull out the Light Units.</p>	 <p>STEP 3: Pull off the transparent tubes from the Light Units.</p>	 <p>STEP 4: Use the tool to push the batteries out of the battery compartment. Don't touch the electric board with your fingers.</p>
 <p>STEP 5: Replace all the batteries according to the correct polarization (+ and -) required.</p>	 <p>STEP 6: Replace the transparent tubes back onto the Light Units.</p>	 <p>STEP 7: Insert the Light Units back into the ball and push them down.</p>	 <p>STEP 8: Carefully reinsert the caps back into the holes. Use your thumb to push the caps down.</p>	 <p>STEP 9: Use the tool if necessary to adjust the cap securely into place.</p>
