Infrared wavelengths are very healthy as they travel deep into the body, creating warming of the cells and tissue.





Assembly Instructions of the Pet Panel:


- 1. Set up your crate if not already done.
- 2. Unbox all panels and cables.
- 3. Each panel should have a label signifying where it goes (Top, Left, Right, Back). Position yourself facing the front of the crate so that the Left panel will go on your left side.




- 4. Panels can be gently leaned against a crate with the bulbs facing inward.
- The left panel will have a blue connector in front and a yellow connector in the back.
- The back panel will have yellow on the left and black on right.
- The right panel will have black (not used) on the front and grey on the back.
- The top panel will have blue at the front and grey at back.
- 5. In the baggy, you'll find metal hooks to attach the tops of the Left, Back, and Right panels to the top of the crate. The L shape can be screwed into the top of the panels. The hook piece can then go into the L shape at the proper level. These are adjustable to best fit your crate.




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
- 6. Cables can now be attached as:
- Blue will connect the Top front to the Left front.




• Yellow will connect Left back-to-Back left.




• Grey will connect the Top back-to-Back right.




7. The power supply can be screwed into side or back panels, whichever is most convenient. The other end of the power supply will connect to the blue wall outlet cable.




8. The ON/OFF switch is found on the back panel, right side. Red is for the red bulbs and green is for the Near-infrared bulbs (when on, the bulbs will show a very dull red light).




9. The power cord can be attached to the timer and then inserted into the wall outlet.




- 10. Turn on both red and green switches and then on the timer, press the button to toggle through the minutes.
- 11. The infrared mat can now be inserted into the cage with the stones toward the top and the connection piece toward the back left. Take the wall plug and insert it from the outside of the crate at the very bottom and connect.



- 12. Plug into the wall outlet. Best to keep the temperature on the lower side until you know what your pet is comfortable with.
- 13. Place the pee mat, white side up, onto the infrared mat.



14. Your cage is ready to go!



Directions of Use:

Many cats and dogs will gravitate toward the heat and the light when you turn it on. But it helps to lure them with treats. The heat pad can be used or not. This depends on your pet as well as the time of year. During the Summer, they might not need extra heat. As the pad needs a few minutes to warm up, that can be started 5 minutes earlier, or just start with the lights. Best to start slow to make sure your pet is comfortable. So just 5 minutes is good. You can slowly add 5 minutes each time until you reach a max of 30 minutes. If your pet has dark hair, it can absorb a greater amount of light and may create uncomfortable warmth. It's best to allow your pet to exit when they feel they've had enough.

8. TORCH:

The torch uses a combination of blue 460nm, red 630nm 660nm, and Infrared 850nm & 940nm LEDs which are chosen to give the ideal light intensity for biological effects anywhere on the body.

Directions of Use:

- 1. Hold the unit for 3 minutes over the treatment area at a distance anywhere from touching the skin to 1 inch away from the skin.
- 2. Darker fur/hair can absorb light and build heat. It is best to divide the hair into parts as much as possible and place the torch directly on the skin.
- 3. Lower the time to 1-2 minutes if you notice uncomfortable warmth in the area.
- 4. Use blue when there is a possibility of bacteria such as cuts, scrapes, and skin issues.
- 5. Pulsing light has shown greater benefit over non-pulsed in recent research studies.

Selecting Options:

Press the "Power button" once quickly, then:

- Press the button once, and all LEDs turn on.
- Press again, and only red (630nm 660nm) & near-infrared (850nm 940nm) will be on, and blue (460nm) off. Note that near-infrared light is invisible to the human eye so the LEDs may be off when in fact the infrared is on.
- Press again, only the blue (460nm) LED is on, and the other LEDs are off.
- Press again, and all LEDs will turn off.

If you press the power button for more than 5 seconds:

- All LEDs will begin to pulse.
- Press again and only red (630nm 660nm) & near-infrared (850nm 940nm) begin to pulse.
- Press again and only the blue (460nm) LED will pulse.
- Press again and all LEDs will turn off.

Usage Frequency:

Use the device 1-3 times per day for at least 4 weeks, and a duration of 3 minutes on one treatment area before moving the device to the next treatment area. Do not keep the device ON for more than 3 minutes at a time. If you want to treat several parts of your body consecutively, TURN OFF the device for at least 1 MINUTE, after every 3 minutes ON. This will keep the unit from overheating.

Maintenance:

For cleaning, we recommend slightly moist alcohol wipes.

Battery:

Insert the provided battery into the battery compartment by unscrewing your torch. Be sure to orient the battery correctly:

The positive pole faces the top.

The negative pole faces the bottom.

- * Please remove the battery for extended periods of nonuse.
- * Only use 18650 batteries.

When to use the intraoral attachment:

For pain relief for small treatment areas in hard-to-reach places like the nose, mouth, and ears. please remove the ring on the top of the torch and screw the attachment into the torch body.

Caution:

- 1. Don't treat near the eyes.
- 2. Don't stare directly at the light. Use protective glasses while using the device.
- 3. This device is not waterproof. Do not submerge the torch or its components in water.
- 4. Do not use pulse mode if you or your pet suffer from epilepsy.
- 5. Do not use the torch if your pet is light-sensitive or is currently using medication or undergoing treatment that may cause light sensitivity.
- 6. Ask your doctor before use if your pet:
 - Is taking drugs known to cause light sensitivity?
 - Is or possibly pregnant.
 - Has a history of sensitivity to light therapy.
