

# User Manual: Rocksolar 4 to 1 Solar Branch Connectors MMMMF+FFFFM Pair

- 1 x MMMMF (Male-Male-Male-Female) Connector
- 1 x FFFFM (Female-Female-Female-Male) Connector

## **Technical Specifications**

### **Precautions**

- 1. Prior to installation, ensure all your equipment is compatible with these connectors. The connectors are designed to work seamlessly with standard solar cables and panels.
- 2. Always ensure the connectors are dry and clean before use.
- 3. Make sure you are in a safe environment before beginning installation.

#### Installation Procedure

- 1. **Identify the Connectors**: The male connector will have metal pins, while the female connector will have metal sleeves.
- 2. **Panel Alignment**: Identify the positive and negative terminals of your solar panels. Ensure they match with the corresponding connectors (Male for Negative and Female for Positive).
- Connection: Insert the male connector from your solar panel cable into the female connector of the Rocksolar branch connector and vice versa. Ensure they click into place, indicating a secure connection.
- 4. **Check Connection**: Gently pull on each connector to ensure they are securely connected. If they come apart, repeat step 3.
- 5. **Repeat**: Repeat steps 2-4 for the remaining solar panel connections.

## Maintenance and Cleaning

- 1. Clean the connectors regularly to ensure optimal performance. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe off any dust or debris.
- 2. If the connectors are exposed to heavy rainfall or any other form of water, make sure to dry them off completely before using.
- 3. Check connections regularly to ensure they are secure.

# **Troubleshooting**

- 1. **Connectors Not Fitting**: If the connectors are not fitting into each other, check to ensure you are connecting a male to a female connector and vice versa.
- 2. **Loose Connections**: If the connections are coming apart, ensure you hear a click when you join the connectors. If not, push harder until they snap into place.
