 $\cdot$  You have purchased an outsole set in accordance with ISO standard 23223, which provides increased comfort and better grip when walking, but is not intended for climbing or mountaineering. This outsole set bears the product identification 'Gripwalk®' and is compatible with the following binding systems:

Touring ski bindings in accordance with ISO standard 13992
Alpine ski bindings in accordance with ISO standard 9462 with the additional marking 'Gripwalk®'.
Alpine and touring bindings with an adjustable AFD height (marked "MN" for MutiNorm)

## **GENERAL WARNING NOTES**

• Skiers may thus exclusively use these outsoles with the binding systems listed above.



The use of these outsoles with other binding systems can lead to the failure of the ski-boot-binding combination and impair the release function.

• We recommend skiers contact a specialist retailer to obtain detailed information about the binding systems that are compatible with these outsoles.

• Kästle recommends as a matter of urgency, particularly before the skiing season and after any change of the outsoles, that you contact a specialist retailer to check the correct fit of the ski-bootbinding combination with suitable measuring equipment and, if required, have the system readjusted.

# **FITTING NOTES**

The 'Gripwalk®' outsoles are removable and must be replaced when worn and/or damaged. Kästle guarantees that the outsoles can be affixed and removed up to 5 times, provided that the following instructions are noted:

- Only use a hand screwdriver to losen and remove the 9 screws from the outsole and to screw the new outsoles in place.

- Remove the outsoles from the boot at the front and back.
- Position the new outsoles as precisely and closely as possible.
- Screw the new outsoles in place by hand with a tightening torque of 1,5 Nm.

To label the fitted outsoles, we recommend affixing the enclosed Gripwalk  $\ensuremath{\$}$  sticker to the boot in a clearly visible location.
