# Recap of April's General Meeting, "Create a Symbolic Portrait"



I believe that any form of art is God's answer to our journey in life. It gives us pleasure and happiness in seeing how we create objects to enjoy.


I graduated from high school in 1958, received an AA in 19772, and a BA in 1989. In all of those classes, I have taken no art course.
