

ROOFTOP PVC CARGO BAG USER MANUAL

WARNING!

- Installation is the end user's responsibility and beyond THORNY DEVIL's control. Therefore, THORNY DEVIL exclusively limits its warranty to the repair or replacement of a defective product. Damage to your vehicle, your cargo or any person or property is excluded.
- DO NOT lift or take down the carrier bag full of luggage by pulling the rack straps attached to the bag.
- Place more luggage to AVOID the zipper lying flat, so as to reduce the water accumulation on the zipper.
- INSPECT for signs of wear and damage BEFORE each use. DO NOT use if worn or damaged.
- DO NOT EXCEED your vehicle's rated roof capacity.
- DO NOT attempt to modify your rainproof cargo bag or any of the system components. Sharp objects must be properly wrapped and secured so as not to puncture the cargo bag.
- DO NOT use your rainproof cargo bag to transport people, animals, flammable liquids, or for purpose other than those for which it was designed.
- Remove your cargo bag when not in use and before entering automatic car washes.
- Check local and state laws governing projection of objects beyond the perimeter of a vehicle. Be aware of the width and height of your cargo since low clearance branches, bridges, and parking garages can affect the load.
- Your rainproof cargo bag will not prevent property damage that may result from improper loading, securing, or driving.
- It is the responsibility of the driver of the vehicle to ensure the cargo bag is correctly secured before driving the vehicle.

INSTALLATION ON CARGO CARRIER

- Inspect cargo bag for any missing straps or damage.
 Make sure the straps and buckles are intact.
- Place the empty cargo bag on the cargo carrier. Ensure the cargo bag is facing forwards - with the handle facing towards the FRONT of the car.
- Open the bag and load cargo into the bag. Place heavy, large objects in first. This may require a second person help you. Continue loading lighter items on the top creating a compact load.
- Close the zipper completely, and fold the yellow flap down so that the zipper is completely covered. Use the hook & loop tabs to hold this flap in place.
- Pass the straps through the cargo carrier and the bag as pictured and buckle the straps. Ensure all straps are tightened as much as they can be.
- Before driving vehicle, ensure the cargo bag is properly secured.
