

Alocasia Elephant Ear Care Guide





Prefers bright, indirect light or partial shade. Direct sunlight can scorch leaves and too little light can cause yellowing of the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Loves consistantly moist, but well drained soil. Prefers high humidity. Mist often and use a pebble tray or place a humidifer near by.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 70-85°F



Food

Feed once a month with a slow-release, water-soluble 20-20-20 fertilizer.



Toxicity

Mildly toxic to pets and humans if ingested.



Growers Tips

Don't panic if your elephant ear loses a couple of leaves when first brought home. It is getting used to its new environment.

If you notice leaning or uneven growth, you may need to move your elephant ear closer to a light source.
