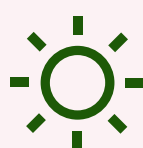




Alocasia Polly

Care Guide



Light

Prefers bright, indirect, filtered light. Direct sunlight can scorch leaves.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top quarter of the soil is dry. Water until liquid flows through the drainage holes at the bottom of the pot. Discard any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Prefers high humidity. Mist often.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-85°F



Food

Feed once a month during the spring and summer with a liquid fertilizer for indoor plants.



Toxicity

Mildly toxic to pets and humans if ingested.



Growers Tips

Goes through a dormant period in the winter months. During this time, keep your Alocasia Polly in a warmer spot in your home. Reduce the watering, but do not allow the soil to completely dry out. It will perk up again in the spring.
