Care Guide

Light

Prefers bright, indirect light to full sun.

Water & Humidity

Let soil dry between waterings and keep it in a well draining container. Does not require additional humidity and can handle dry conditions.

Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-85°F

Food

It is not necessary to fertilize Aloe plants. If you wish, you can fertilize your aloe plant once in the spring with a phosphorus-heavy, water-based fertilizer at half strength.

Toxicity

Aloe is safe for humans to ingest and use on skin. Aloe is toxic to pets if ingested.

Growers Tips

Aloe Vera has a rather shallow root system that likes to spread out close to the surface. As the plant grows and needs repotting, move up to a wider pot, rather than a deeper one.
