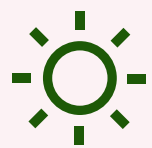


# Arabica Coffee Care Guide



## Light

Prefers bright, indirect sunlight. Direct sunlight can cause leaves to brown.



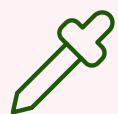
## Water & Humidity

Keep soil moist and well drained. Prefers high humidity, so be sure to mist often. You may also set on a water filled pebble tray to increase humidity.



## Temperature

Ideal temperature is 64-70°F



## Food

Feed every 2-3 months during the spring and summer with a liquid fertilizer for indoor plants.



## Toxicity

Aside from the fruit and its seed, all parts of the plant are toxic to pets and humans if ingested.



## Growers Tips

Goes through a dormant period in the winter months. During this time, keep your Arabica Coffee plant in a warmer spot in your home. Reduce the watering, but do not allow the soil to completely dry out.

Should be pruned in the spring to help maintain shape. Make sure to cut 1/4 inch above the stem at a 45 degree angle.
