



Areca Palm

Care Guide



Light

Thrives in bright, indirect light. Direct sunlight may burn the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Water often enough to keep the soil lightly moist in spring and summer, and allow the soil to dry slightly between waterings in fall and winter. Areca's love humidity, so they can benefit from misting or placing a humidifier near by.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-75°F



Food

The areca palm is a heavy feeder and requires fertilizing from spring to early fall with a liquid fertilizer, following label instructions. Do not feed during the late fall and winter when the plant is dormant.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

You can prune your Areca Palm to maintain a certain size or shape. Pruning also encourages more branching, which will make your Palm look more full. The best time to prune is springtime when their growth naturally increases.
