



Australian Fern

Care Guide



Light

Extremely adaptable to many light conditions from full sunlight to partial shade.



Water & Humidity

Keep the soil moist at all times. Australian tree ferns are not drought-tolerant and need weekly watering, with especially high levels of moisture or humidity in dry weather. Avoid watering the crown directly as this can cause rot—instead, water the trunk and ensure it's consistently moist.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-80°F



Food

During the growing season, feed your Australian tree fern with controlled-release fertilizer monthly, or biweekly with weak liquid fertilizer.



Toxicity

Toxic to pets and humans if ingested.



Growers Tips

Tree ferns do not require pruning but for a neater appearance, you can remove withered and dead fronds.

An Australian tree fern will grow rapidly, so make sure you plant it somewhere in your landscape where it has room to grow and expand. If you're growing your tree fern in a container, repot it annually into a larger pot (with fresh soil).
