

Birds Nest Fern

Care Guide





Thrives in medium to low indirect light. Be sure not to place in direct sunlight or the leaves will turn a pale color.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top quarter of the soil is dry. Be sure to water only the soil and avoid the leaves to prevent rot. Remove any water that has accumulated in the drainage saucer. Birds Nest Ferns love humidity. Mist often. Would benefit from placing a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-80°F



Food

Feed once a month during the spring and summer with a liquid fertilizer for indoor plants.



Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Regularly remove any dead fronds from the plant to encourage healthy new growth. Cut stems at the soil line with clean, sharp shears.
