Care Guide



Light

Thrives in medium to bright indirect light. Be sure not to place in direct sunlight or the leaves can burn.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top quarter of the soil is dry. Make sure to remove any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Calatheas love humidity. Mist them with lukewarm water on a regular basis, use a pebble tray, or place a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-85°F



Food

You can use a general houseplant fertilizer once a month during the spring and summer. No fertilizer is necessary during the winter when plant growth naturally slows.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

Can benefit from dusting the leaves with a damp cloth from time to time. If you notice burnt or yellowish leaves, it could be due to your tap water. Tap water sometimes contains salts, chlorine, and fluoride. You can leave the tap water in an open container overnight before watering to help remove some of the chemicals. You can also use filtered water or rainwater.
