

Christmas Cactus Care Guide



Light

Can tolerate low and medium light conditions, but thrives in bright indirect light. Will produce more blooms when exposed to more light. Be careful of direct sunlight, as it may burn the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Water only when the top third of the soil has dried. Make sure to remove any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Loves humidity, be sure to mist often. Would benefit from placing a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 60-70°F



Food

From spring through early fall, feed every 2 weeks with a balanced houseplant fertilizer. During the fall and winter, feed the cactus monthly to encourage successful blooming.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

Prune plants in late spring to encourage branching and more flowers. Simply cut off a few sections of each stem; the plant will branch from the wound.
