Dracaena Colorama Care Guide



Light

Thrives in bright indirect light. Too much direct sun can scotch the leaves, too little light can hinder the plants coloring.



Water

On average, Dracaena Colorama needs to be watered once a week from spring until mid-autumn. During the colder months, you can reduce the watering frequency to once every 10-14 days. If it feels particularly wet, let it dry out for longer. Over watering can lead to fungal issues or root rot.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65=80°F



Food

Dracaena marginata plants do well when given balanced fertilizers with an NPK ratio of 5-5-5. This provides plenty of nitrogen to fuel bushy leaf growth.



Toxicity

Toxic to human and pets if ingested.



Growers Tips

Pale leaves, slow growth, and small new leaves indicate it is not getting enough light. You can use clean, sharp scissors or shears to trim tips, pull away dead leaves from the stem, and prune stems to manage growth and size.
