# EXCHANGE Dwarf Ming Aralia Tree Care Guide





Prefers bright, indirect light and can even handle low light conditions. Be careful not to place in direct sunlight as it will scorch the leaves.



### Water & Humidity

Water when the top 2 inches of the soil is dry. Water until liquid flows through the drainage holes at the bottom of the pot. Discard any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Prefers higher humidity. You can mist or place a humidifier nearby.



#### Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-85°F

## Food

Feed your Ming aralia with a liquid fertilizer monthly throughout its growing period (spring through fall). If you notice falling leaves or those that are yellowish-green in appearance, that's a good indication that your plant isn't getting enough nutrients and could benefit from a bit of fertilizer.



Mildly toxic if ingested or if sap touches the skin.

# **Growers Tips**

It is recommended to prune Ming Aralia during cold months - this way you'll avoid making damage to the plant since the growing is quite reduced. If you want your Ming Aralia to be thick with a dense covering of leaves, you should trim the tips to encourage more rapid branching. Prune it to control its upright habit.
