Fiddle Leaf Fig Care Guide





Thrives in consistent bright, indirect light. Turn your plant every few months if you see it leaning towards the light.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top half to three quarters of the soil is dry. Allow the liquid to flow through the drainage holes. Remove any excess water from the drainage saucer to prevent root rot. Loves higher humidity, mist regularly.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 60-85°F. Avoid cold drafts.

Food

Feed your plant once during the spring and monthly throughout the summer. Be careful not to over fertilize. No fertilizer is necessary during the winter when plant growth naturally slows.



Mildly toxic to humans and pets if ingested.



Fiddle Leaf Figs do not like to be moved. If it is necessary to move your plant, be prepared for some leaf drop. Your plant will get acclimated again in approximately 2-3 weeks.
