

# Gardenia Indoor Care Guide







Needs 5-6 hours of bright direct light or partial sun to thrive.

## **Water & Humidity**

Keep soil evenly moist during the growing season, slightly drier in winter. Use a pot with a drainage hole and allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Gardenias love humidity. Use a room humidifier or place the pot on a tray of wet pebbles. Misting year round is a good idea. With gardenia care should be taken to mist the foliage, and not the flowers.



### **Temperature**

Ideal temperature is 60-75°F. Keep your plant free of drafts and never place a gardenia where it will receive the direct force of hot air from a furnace.



#### **Food**

Feed every 2 weeks during the growing season with a high-potassium fertilizer specially made for acid-loving plants. Only fertilize when watering to avoid fertilizer burn.



# **Toxicity**

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



# **Growers Tips**

Pruning gardenia plants in late winter will keep them in good shape. Cut the stem at an angle, just above a node (the place where a leaf or branch is attached to the stem). Use sharp pruners to avoid tearing the stems.
