## Hoya Care Guide



Needs bright, indirect light and will thrive if you provide them with a couple of hours of direct morning or evening.



## Water & Humidity

Prefers the soil to dry out a bit between waterings. Achieves best growth in high humidity conditions. Mist daily or place a humidifier nearby.



## Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-80°F



## Food

From Spring to Fall you can use a high nitrogen fertilizer monthly on moist soil. This will promote foliage growth.



Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Never cut the long tendrils! Leaves and flower clusters develop from these. Hoyas don't mind being a bit root bound, you can keep them in the same pot for years.
