

Jasmine

Care Guide





Requires full sun to partial shade.



Water & Humidity

Water weekly, letting the soil dry out in between waterings. If planted outside, you may need to increase or decrease the amount of water depending on the weather.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 70-75°F. Can be planted outdoors in USDA hardiness zones 7-10.



Food

Jasmine plants don't often require fertilizer outdoors, but a 7-9-5 fertilizer works well if potted indoors.



Most varieties are toxic to humans and pets if ingested.



Pinch off the tips of the vines in the second year to promote branching which will fill the trellis with bushy growth.
