

Kimberly Queen Fern Care Guide





Thrives in bright indirect light, but can survive in direct sun if the soil remains moist.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top quarter of the soil is dry. Make sure to remove any extra water from the draining saucer. Prefers higher humidity and can benefit from a daily misting or a humidifier placed nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-80°F



Food

You can use a general houseplant fertilizer diluted to half strength once every three months. Never feed a fern when the soil is dry, it will burn the fronds.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and animals.



Growers Tips

Remove dead fronds to encourage new healthy growth.
