

# Lady Palm Rhapis Excelsa Care Guide





Can tolerate low and medium light conditions, but thrives in bright indirect light. Direct sunlight may burn the leaves.



### **Water & Humidity**

Water only when the top half of the soil has dried. Make sure to remove any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Can tolerate average household humidity, but will benefit from misting or placing a humidifier nearby.



#### **Temperature**

Ideal temperature is 60-80°F



#### **Food**

Feed once a month during spring and summer with a general houseplant fertilizer diluted to half strength.



#### **Toxicity**

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



## **Growers Tips**

Tap water sometimes contains fluoride, chlorine, or other chemicals that damage palms, so it's a good idea to use distilled or rainwater to water your palm. Always use room temperature water when watering your tropical house plants because cold water is a shock to them.
