

Lipstick Palm Care Guide



It's best to keep your lipstick palm in partial shade or filtered sunlight until it's older. Afterward, it handles part shade and full sun equally well.



Water & Humidity

The best soils are rich, loamy, moist soils with low acidity. Keep soil consistently moist, but well-drained. Discard any water that has accumulated in the saucer. Prefers high humidity and would benefit from a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 75-85°F



Food

A well-balanced, slow-release palm fertilizer should be applied twice a year during the growing season.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to pets and humans.

Growers Tips

Prune off any damaged or diseased fronds that have lost their color to keep your palm healthy.

Make sure to bring your palm inside if temperatures dip below 55°F. Also, keep your palm away from cold drafts inside as it can send your plant into shock.
