



Madagascar Palm

Care Guide



Light

Thrives in full sun. Requires 6 hours of sun per day.



Water & Humidity

The madagascar palm enjoys dry soil, so be sure to only water it well after the soil is completely dry to the touch. Only needs average humidity.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 75-90°F



Food

Madagascar Palm grows very slowly and doesn't require added fertilizer. Replacing your plant's potting soil once a year should provide them with more than enough nutrition.



Toxicity

Toxic to humans and pets if ingested..



Growers Tips

The madagascar palm is actually a succulent and will be a slow grower if kept indoors as a houseplant. Wear thick gloves when handling these houseplants as their spines are sharp and toxic. If your Palm starts to lean and reach towards the light source, then rotate your plants to maintain a straight trunk
