



# Mammy Croton

## Care Guide



### Light

Thrives in bright light with 2-3 hours of sun per day. Too much direct sun can scorch the leaves, too little light can hinder the plants coloring.



### Water

Your Croton Mammy watering goal should be to keep the soil moderately moist at all times without ever letting it get sopping wet. The ideal humidity is 40-80 percent.



### Temperature

Ideal temperature is 60=80°F



### Food

Only apply fertilizer for *Codiaeum variegatum* Mammy 3 times a year, at the beginning of spring, summer, and autumn. Never fertilize in winter when it is dormant. Use a granular fertilizer with a fertilizer ratio of 20-3-19. Simply sprinkle it on the surface of the soil before watering



### Toxicity

Toxic to human and pets if ingested.



### Growers Tips

Do not prune your crotons in autumn or winter so that they can heal from the stress quickly. When pruning the leaves, remove the petiole of each leaf that you remove. Also, you should make sure that your pruning tool is clean and disinfected. You can remove leaves with colors that you do not like.
