



# Milkweed

## Care Guide



### Light

Requires at least 6-8 hours of full sun per day.



### Water & Humidity

When planted outside, milkweeds do not need any extra watering except during droughts. You can water weekly during droughts to soak the soil about 2-3 inches deep.



### Temperature

Can be planted outdoors in USDA hardiness zones 4-9.



### Food

There is no need to fertilize your milkweed plant, as it can tolerate even poor soil.



### Toxicity

Toxic to humans and pets if ingested.



### Growers Tips

Milkweed plant is the sole host plant for Monarch Butterflies and an important nectar source for bees and other insects. Planting Milkweed in your garden is sure to attract a variety of visitors.
