

Monstera Adansonii Care Guide





Can survive in low light conditions, but thrives in medium to bright indirect light. Be careful of too much direct sunlight, as it may scorch the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Water when the top three quarters of the soil is dry. Make sure to remove any accumulated water from your saucer to prevent root rot. Can tolerate average household humidity, but will thrive in extra humidity. Mist daily or add a humidifier nearby.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 60-80°F



Food

You can use a regular houseplant fertilizer diluted to half strength, during the spring and summer months.





Moderately toxic to humans and pets if ingested.

Growers Tips

Can benefit from regular dusting, as the leaves easily accumulate dust. Monsteras love to climb, you can encourage your plant with garden ties or hooks to guide it where you would like.
