



Persian Shield

Care Guide



Light

Thrives in partial shade or indirect sunlight. Too much direct sunlight can scorch the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Needs constantly moist soil. Thrives in high humidity and would benefit from a humidifier nearby or a daily misting.



Temperature

Needs to be above 60°F



Food

Fertilize with a plant food with nitrogen every two weeks during the peak growing season, but you can stop during the winter and fall.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

If you choose to keep your Persian Shields in a pot, replot annually when the plant is young. As a Persian Shield plant matures, replot every other year. This is a fast-growing plant. If it becomes too large and pruning is not controlling the size, try pruning the roots.
