

Dwarf Pomegranate Care Guide





Requires full sun to thrive, but can tolerate partial shade.



Water & Humidity

Needs consistently moist soil. Will become more drought tolerant once mature and established. Thrives in average humidity.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-75°F. Can be planted outdoors in USDA hardiness zones 7-11.



Food

Feed every 2 weeks spring through fall with a water-soluble fertilizer specially made for fruit trees.



Toxicity

Non-toxic to humans and pets.



Growers Tips

It is important to prune your Pomegranate tree. Prune out any crossing branches or shoots to three to five per branch after the tree's first year. Prune out any dead or damaged limbs in the late winter. Prune out suckers to create a more tree-like appearance.
