Thrives in bright indirect light to full sun. Too much direct sunlight may scorch the leaves.



Water & Humidity

Water when the soil is completely dry and make sure to remove any accumulated water from your saucer. Ponytail Palms are extremely drought tolerant and thrive in dry conditions.



Temperature

Ideal temperature is 65-75°F



Food

Only needs to be fertilized once in the spring and summer with a general houseplant fertilizer. Too much fertilizing can cause the leaves to brown.





Non-toxic to humans and pets.

! Growers Tips

Ponytail Palm leaves are sensitive to injury and tend to get dark at the ends. You may cut the browning pieces off to preserve the apperance of your plant. Becareful not to remove more than 20% of the leaves at a time or you may put your plant into shock.
