

# Pothos Care Guide





Pothos thrives in bright but indirect light, however this plant will also comfortably adapt to low and medium light spaces.



# **Water & Humidity**

Water your Pothos every 1-2 weeks, allowing soil to dry out between waterings. Expect to water more often in brighter light and less often in lower light. Pothos prefer higher humidity, place a humidifier near by or mist often.



### **Temperature**

Ideal temperature is 70-90°F



#### **Food**

As a fairly fast-growing plant, pothos plants need regular fertilization, especially in the spring and summer, which is their typical growing season. You can buy fertilizer in two forms: pellets/slow-release fertilizer and liquid fertilizer.



## **Toxicity**

Toxic to humans and pets if ingested.



# **Growers Tips**

Can benefit from regular dusting, as the leaves easily accumulate dust. Pothos love to climb, you can encourage your plant with garden ties or hooks to guide it where you would like.
