

Stella De Oro Daylily Care Guide





Prefers full sun, but will tolerate partial shade.



Water & Humidity

Requires medium moisture and well draining soil. Can handle 2-3 weeks of drought once established.



Temperature

Can be planted outdoors in USDA hardiness zones 3-10.



Food

In ideal soil conditions, your 'Stella de Oro's don't require fertilizer. They will appreciate a thick layer of organic mulch applied each spring. If flowering is weak, you can use a slow-release granular fertilizer in the spring and immediately after the first major flowering period.



Toxicity

Mildly toxic to humans and pets if ingested.



Growers Tips

The secret to getting your Stella De Oro's to constantly bloom is to remove the spent flowers. You can do so by pinching or cutting the flower and its stem from the plant's main stem.
