Guidelines for Fences in MLII

Clarification of Sections 6.2 & 8.11 of the RCA

- 1. All new fences must be approved by the ARC in advance as has always been the case.
- 2. Any fences not approved by the ARC that do not conform to the guidelines will be modified or removed at owner's expense, regardless of install date.
- 3. Repairs/replacement of existing fences requires the approval of the ARC as has always been the case.
- 4. Split Rail fences are not allowed; front, back or sides.
- 5. Chain-link or plastic mesh is not allowed as a material.
- 6. Animal fencing (wire) is not allowed.
- 7. Setbacks and clearances to neighboring lots, lake lines and easements shall be adhered to.
- 8. Although each fence will be evaluated on its "form and fit", the ARC will discourage front-facing fences not conforming to a range of 4'-5' max.
- 9. Privacy fences will be evaluated on a case by case basis.
- 10. Painting/Staining that is approved by the ARC shall be completed in an expeditious manner.
