A B O U T

The LaZer Peel is a medium-depth peel (pH 1.7) that combines multiple acids to deliver a brightening effect, similar to a laser treatment.

Glycolic Acid 34.3%, Citric 10%, Lactic Acid 9.99%, Tranexamic Acid 5%, Salicylic Acid 2%, Hexylresorcinol 2%, Ascorbyl Glucoside .5%

Hexylresorcinol is an anti-pigment agent that has been shown to be 4 times more effective than hydroquinone, and without the side effects.

This is a standalone treatment - meaning, we do not recommend incorporating the LaZer peel into any facials. This is strictly a peel service.

BENEFITS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

1. KrX Pre Peel Cleanser
2. KrX Pre Peel Toner
3. KrX LaZer Peel
4. KrX Post Peel Toner
5. KrX Repair Cream

PROTOCOL

1. Cleanse the skin
2. Apply Pre Peel Toner
3. Apply LaZer Peel following this schedule:
1st treatment: apply 1 layer for 1 minute.
2nd treatment: 1 layer for 2 minutes or 2 layers for 1 minute.
3rd treatment: apply 2 layers for 2 minutes or 3 layers for 1 minute
4. Remove with COLD water followed by Post Peel Toner
5. Apply Repair Cream

IMPORTANT - PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

It is very important to follow proper protocol with this peel.

1. For first time clients apply one layer for up to one minute. It doesn't seem like a lot, but even this conservative approach will bring about significant change
2. Change gloves before removing the peel. This peel has an oil base, and the peel can be transferred back to the client's skin.
3. Remove with COLD water and follow up with two layers of post peel toner.

DURING TREATMENT + IMMEDIATELY AFTER

A stinging sensation may occur

DAY 1-5

This is a no downtime peel.

POSTCARE

DO NOT EXFOLIATE

Do not exfoliate the skin for at least 7 days post peel

PROTECT

Stay out of the sun, and protect the skin by applying
Keep skin hydrated with appropriate moisturizer and
SPF daily.

SESSIONS + INTERVALS

Can be done every two weeks

ACCUTANE OR RETIN-A

Do not use on any clients who have used Accutane within a year.

Have clients stop using Retin-A at least 7 days before treatment depending on strength.

AGE RECOMMENDATION

Teens to adults may receive this treatment.
