1/3 Female Factor Infertility



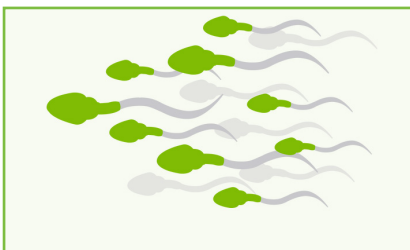
1/3 Male and Female Factor Infertility

Diagnosed Male Factor Infertility

When to get a Cap-Score:

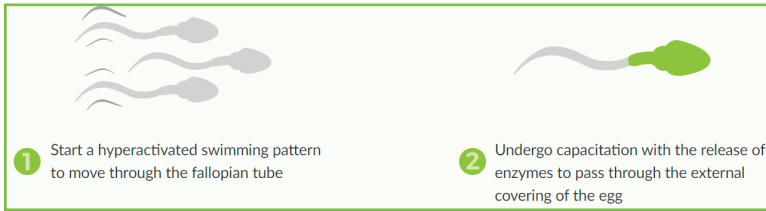
- If you are just starting your journey

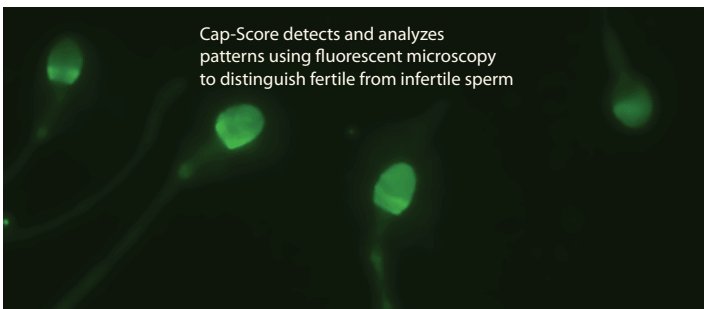

The Science Behind the Cap-Score

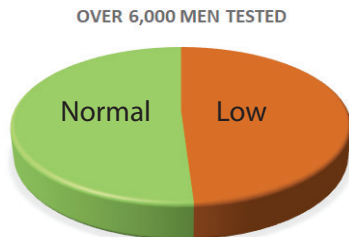
In order to fertilize, your sperm must have the ability to Capacitate. Once inside the female reproductive tract, sperm must:



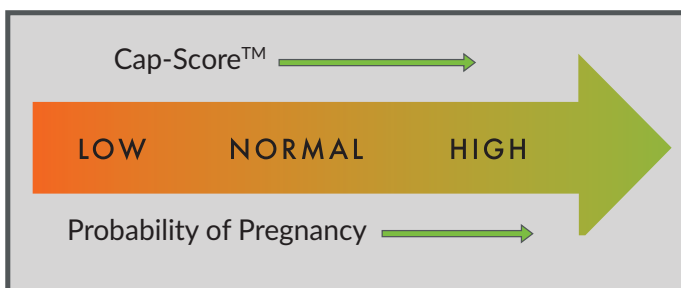
The Cap-Score is the only clinical diagnostic test designed to measure how many sperm in your ejaculate can Capacitate and fertilize an egg.



Out of over 6000 men questioning their fertility, 49% have had Cap-Scores that are abnormally low.



Prospective Studies have shown that men with Low Cap-Scores have very low chances of generating a pregnancy by natural conception or intrauterine insemination (IUI)



Understanding your results

- Receive Personalized guidance from your physician
- Data shows that Cap-Score is the ONLY test that can predict a man's fertility.

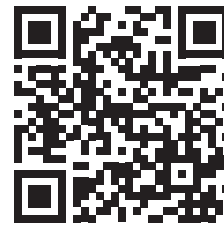
"The ability to determine a man's probability of generating a pregnancy is a substantial advance for all couples when planning their families. This is particularly important when childbirth is being delayed resulting in an increased likelihood of encountering potential problems," said Gianpiero Palermo, MD, PhD, Director of Assisted Fertilization and the Andrology Laboratory at the Ronald O.
