GARLAND SHAPING INSTRUCTIONS:

Shaping a faux garland is a great way to add a natural and festive touch to your space. *Here's how you can do it:*

- $N \odot . I$ Start by unboxing your cedar faux garland and lay it out on a flat surface. This will help you visualize its length and overall shape.
- NO.2 Gently fluff and separate the branches to give the garland a fuller appearance. Work your way from the base of the garland to the tip of each branch, gently pulling the needles outward. This will make it look more realistic and create a lush feel.
- NO.3 Our garland has wired branches, so you can easily bend and shape them to your desired arrangement. You can create a traditional swag shape by bending the garland in the middle and allowing it to curve downwards on both sides.



- NO.4 For a cascading effect, you can attach the garland to a banister or mantel, allowing it to drape down gracefully. You can also twist and turn sections of the garland to create a more whimsical and organic shape.
- NO.5 As you shape the garland, step back from time to time to assess its appearance. Adjust as needed to create a balanced and visually appealing arrangement.
- NO.6 To add depth and interest, consider incorporating other decorative elements such as pinecones, berries, or ornaments. You can attach them to the garland using floral wire or small hooks.

Garland: The back tips should always go to the sides and the remaining tips should be pulled forward alternating slightly right to left of center and one in the center.

Remember, the great thing about our faux garlands is that they are very versatile and forgiving. You can always reshape them as many times as you like until you achieve the desired look. Have fun getting creative and enjoy the festive ambiance your cedar pine garland will bring to your space!
